Tips:

- If a kid doesn't want to do the action that matches the color the spinner lands on, they can curl up, become a rock, and wait until someone unfreezes them.
- Use the color-coded **Spinner Key** below so kids know what each color on the spinner stands for.
- Use the lists of examples next to each color to help kids when they need ideas.

Spinner Key



Say a reason you'd worship God.

- He's good.
- He's kind.
- He's always with me.
- He created everything—and that's amazing.
- He healed my heart when it was sad.
- He healed my body when it was sick.
- He teaches me the best way to live.
- He loves everyone.
- He loved me before I even knew Him.



Do a worship action.

- Pretend to help someone.
- Say, "I forgive you because God forgave me!"
- Raise hands up to God.
- Kneel down like you're praying.
- Tell someone else how much Jesus loves them.
- Pretend to obey your parents or other leaders with a good attitude.
- Pretend to give God a tenth of the money you earn (a tithe!).
- Pretend to go outside and sit quietly, thanking God for His beautiful creation.
- Pretend to read the Bible.



Curl up, freeze, and become a rock.

- You can't spin again unless someone unfreezes you.
- If you're the last person to become a rock, the round is over.



Unfreeze one person who is a rock.

- Yay! You can **unfreeze one person** who has become a rock.
- If there is no one to unfreeze, you may spin again—or become a rock if you'd like.
