BE HONEST

## The Verse

Proverbs 12:22 NLT

*The LORD detests lying lips, but he delights in those who tell the truth.*

## The Point

Godly character is honest.

## Family Activity Directions

### True Story // You'll Need

- Proverbs 12:22 activity sheet (1 per child)
- Markers

### To Do

1. **Give** kids a Proverbs 12:22 activity sheet.

**Say:** Look at the mouth that is trying to say the Bible verse. Let's fill in the blanks!

2. Kids **write** the missing words.

**Ask:** What do the rest of the mouths need to say to show godly character? *The truth*

**Say:** They do need to tell the truth! Write or draw one truth you can say this week in each word bubble.

3. Kids **draw** or **write** truths inside the empty word bubbles.

4. **Help** kids with examples if they need it:

- I'm God's child!
- Jesus loves everyone!
- I can help my family.
- I can finish my chores.
- I can be a leader to my friends.
- I can apologize when I do something wrong.
- I can forgive.
- God's always with me.
- God has good plans for people who love Him.
- I can ask for help when I need it.
- I can take care of my responsibilities.

### Bonus

1. Kids **color** their sheets with markers.
2. Kids **share** what they drew or wrote in the word bubbles.

## CHOOSE BEST QUESTIONS TO ASK

### Get Everyone Talking

1. What was the funniest thing that happened on the Konnect Space Station this week?
2. Cruz really wanted Nitro to seem amazing in the video he was making. What do you think is amazing about Nitro?

### Check For Understanding

1. What kind of character is the Konnect crew learning about? *The kind that describes who you are on the inside.*
2. What happens when your choices show godly character? *My godly character will shine a light so others can see what Jesus is like.*
3. Say Proverbs 12:22 together with the motions. Why do you think God doesn't like it when you lie? *Lying makes you look irresponsible, shows you can't be trusted, and hurts people. If you tell lies AND try to tell people about Jesus, they can't trust what you say about Jesus, either.*
4. Think about the Bible story. How did people feel when they heard Ananias and Sapphira died when they lied? *They felt afraid.*
5. Usually our bodies don't die when we lie. What does die when we lie? *The trust others have in us to tell the truth and be responsible, our ability to show others the truth about Jesus, etc.*
6. When you tell a lie and get away with it, is it a big deal? *Yes, because you know you lied, God knows you lied, and you might be tempted to lie again.*

### Apply To This Week

1. Sometimes we lie about really silly things, like brushing our teeth, cleaning our room, or finishing homework. What silly lies do you need God's help to stop telling? *Answers will vary.*
2. Look at the activity sheet you filled out earlier. Which truth will help you be honest this week? *Answers will vary.*
3. Share the name of someone you've lied to, you need to apologize to, and you need to be honest with so they can trust you again. *Answers will vary.*

**Pray:** Jesus, thank You for being honest and true even when we aren't. Please help us to have honest, godly character like You do, so others can trust us when we share Your love with them. In Jesus' name, amen!
